The special meeting of the Bowdle Board of Education was held on March 17, 2020 at 7:30 p.m. at the Bowdle School with the following members present: Mitzel , Oxner, Schlechter, Frickson, and Stotz.

Others present: Supt. Serna, Carolynn Nelson, Tami Kaaz and Tara Beitelspacher.

Chairman Stotz presided.
